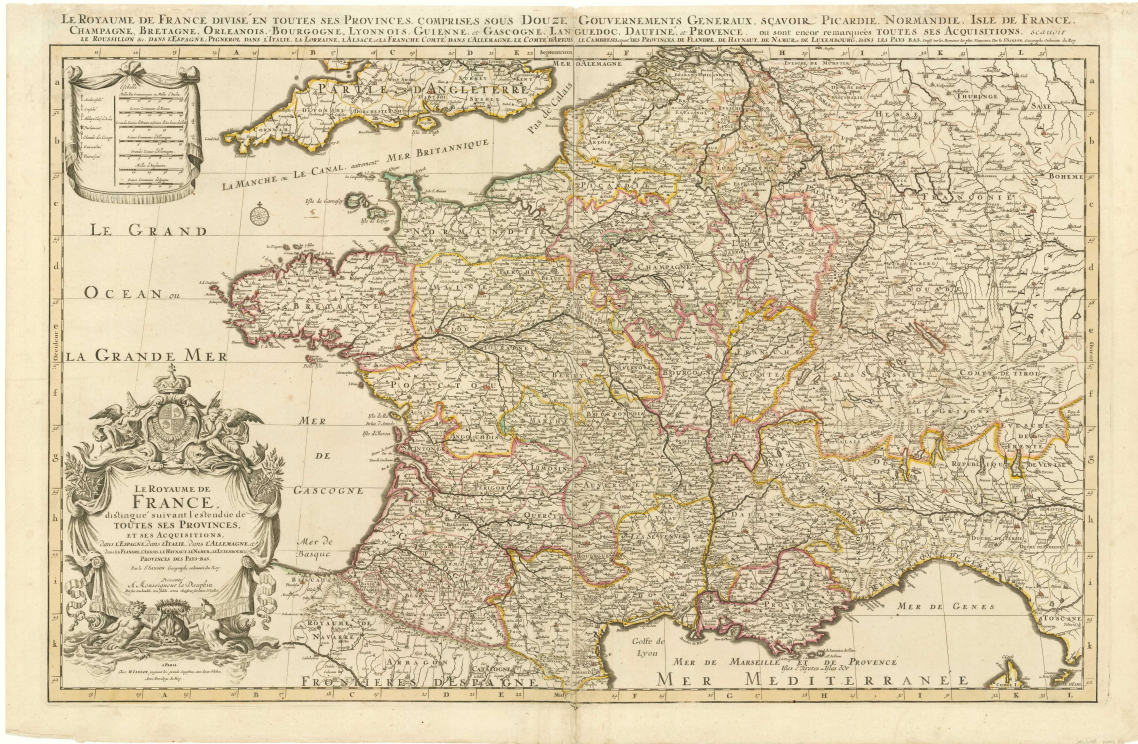




A two-sheet map of France
