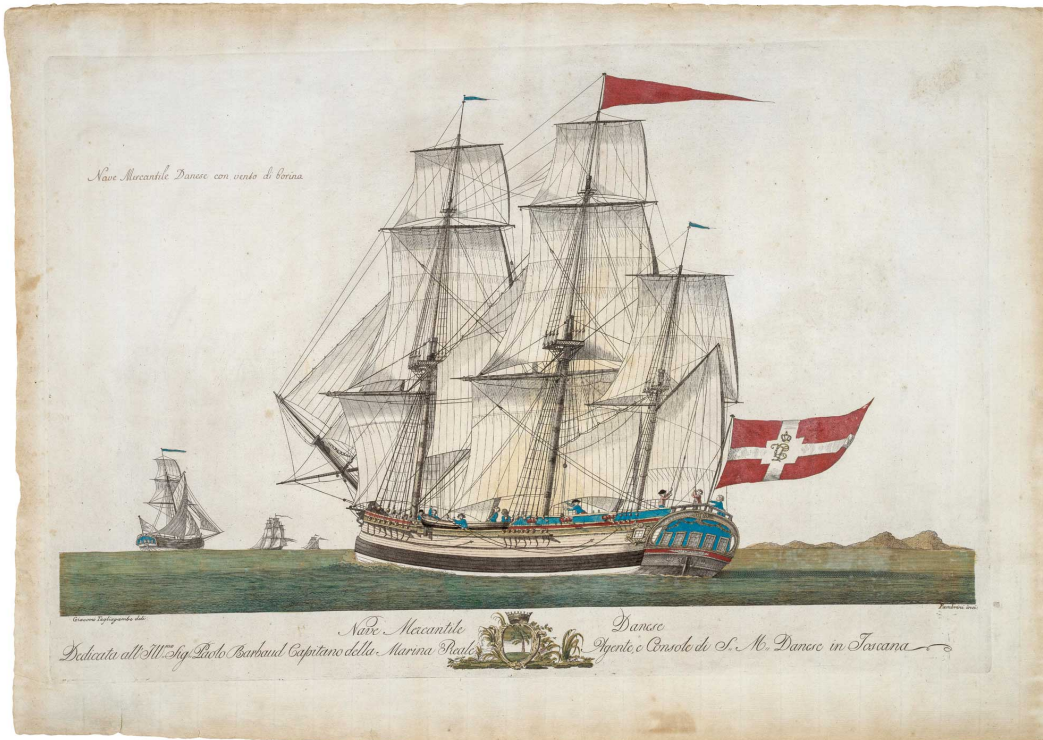




An extremely rare 18th century Italian maritime print

A Danish merchant ship under sail, with the rigging meticulously recorded. The dedication is to Paolo Barbaud, the Danish consul in Livorno. This is one of a series of images of the merchant ships trading with Tuscany engraved by Ferdinando Fambrini, an engraver better known for his prints of local buildings. Tagliagambe's original maritime prints are rare: most examples seen for sale are modern reproductions.

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
