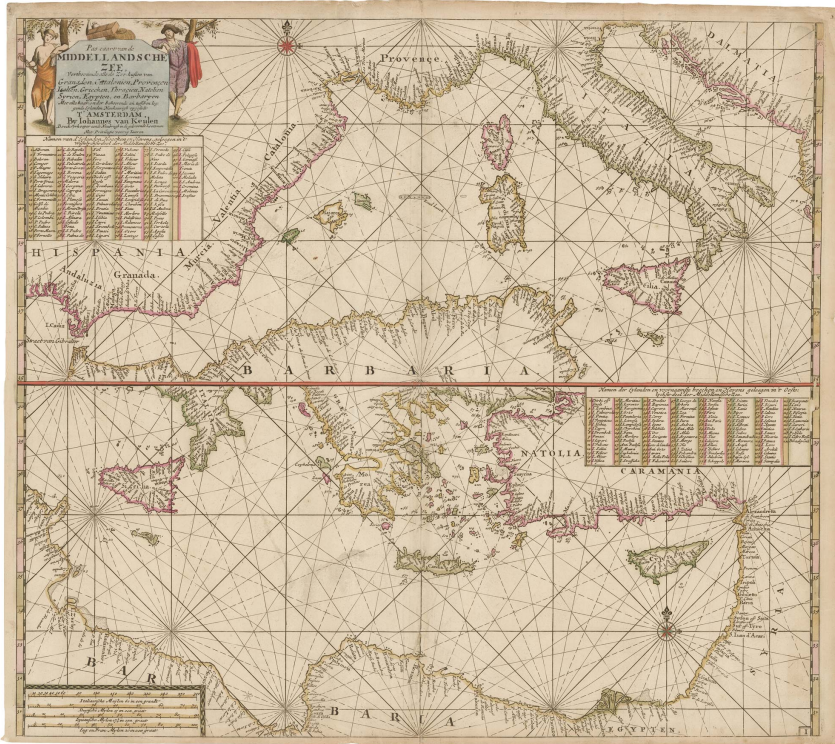




Early 18th century chart of the Mediterranean in fine colour

An uncommon sea chart of the Mediterranean, engraved in two sections on one sheet, both with extensive keys. The upper section covers the Western Mediterranean as far east as Corfu, the lower section the eastern Mediterranean east of Sicily. This example is state ii of ii, with the addition of 'Italian Miles' in the scale. The Van Keulen family dominated the Dutch sea chart market from the 1680s until the mid-19th century.
