A folding map of the environs of Geneva, extending to Beaumont in the south west, clockwise to Collognes, Péron, Saint-Genis-Pouilly, Chevry, Gex, Divonne-les-Bains & Crassier, with Hermance, Machilly and Gaillard south of Lake Geneva. The map was drawn by Henri Mallet (1727-1811) of Geneva and engraved by Guillaume Delahaye, as the Franco-Swiss alliance, with the promise of Swiss independence and neutrality, was being renewed.

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
